



**5<sup>th</sup> WAVO VALUATION CONGRESS**  
**“Meeting the Valuation Needs of a Globalised World”**  
**24-26 November 2010**

**Announcement & Call for Papers**

The 5<sup>th</sup> WAVO Valuation Congress will take place in Singapore in November 2010. The theme is “Meeting the Valuation Needs of a Globalised World”. The world has encountered one of the worst financial crises, and while many jurisdictions have recovered gradually through the various stimulus packages and stringent controls of the financial institutions, a number of valuation issues have emerged.

This 5<sup>th</sup> Congress will take the opportunity to examine the pertinent issues in valuation arising from the recent events and what can be done to improve and raise the level of competencies and professionalism in the valuation fraternity. The Congress will be organized along several key sub-themes for detailed discussion. The suggested sub-themes are as follows:

- Valuations in compliance with international standards
- Business valuations and valuations for financial reporting
- Plant and machinery valuations
- Professional ethics and liability
- Training and education of valuers
- Statutory valuations including property tax assessments
- Specialised valuations, eg golf courses, subterranean rights, theme parks etc

As in the previous congresses, all full papers submitted on time will be considered based on their merit for the Best Research Paper and Best Practice Paper Awards.

An important feature of this 5<sup>th</sup> Congress is the expert panel discussions on two important topics, hosted by the Technical Committees on Specialised Valuations, and Financial Reporting. Other topics will be considered if there is sufficient interest among the participants.

A technical tour will be arranged to one of two newly integrated resorts in Singapore, Marina Sands and Resort World.
